




EVENTS

Educational Visit



Screening Data Points

Our screening camps in hospitals aim to ensure early detection of hearing issues in newborns. Each new mother is informed about key auditory milestones, empowering them to monitor their child's hearing development. To ensure no child is overlooked, we conduct mandatory monthly follow-ups for comprehensive tracking and timely intervention. In addition to this, screening is also conducted within communities.

THE THERAPY



43 children are currently taking AVT sessions in the center. AVT therapy focuses on developing listening and spoken language skills in children with hearing loss through personalized, play-based sessions. In an attempt to encourage the children, a Show and Tell event was organized where the children proudly showed off their newfound speaking skills, talking about their favorite vegetables, a shiny glass, most loved food items, and more—each topic matched perfectly to how far they've come in their journey. The event became a beautiful reminder of Montfort Care's heartfelt mission: to help every child with hearing impairments find their voice and shine bright in their own special way.


AUDIOLOGICAL INTERVENTION

Our audiology lab continues to be a cornerstone of our early intervention efforts, ensuring comprehensive diagnostic and rehabilitative support for children with hearing impairments. Diagnostic tests conducted are Conditioned Pure Tone Audiometry, Brainstem Evoked Response Audiometry (BERA), Immittance Audiometry, and Cochlear Implant Mapping. Our audiologists provided personalized hearing aid fittings to optimize auditory access for each child

LEARNING & DEVELOPMENT



During a three-day webinar, from 7th-10th October 2024, our therapists engaged in comprehensive sessions focused on various strategies to enhance listening skills. They explored the transformative role of music in therapy, book sharing, emphasizing the importance of reading in language development, and coaching parents on how they can actively support their children's auditory and communication skills at home.

• META MODEL SESSION



The Montfort Care team engaged in an impactful session as part of internal training on the Meta Model, a linguistic tool aimed at enhancing communication. Through interactive exercises, team members learned to identify and challenge vague language, uncovering deeper insights that help build clarity in discussions.
