The first 3 years of life are most critical for speech and language development

Awareness camps are conducted 2-3 times every week, reaching out directly to communities. These camps serve as an important platform to spread knowledge about hearing health, early identification of hearing loss, and available intervention services, ensuring that more families become informed beneficiaries of our programs. We try and reach out to un-serviced locations like Ulhasnagar, Bhiwandi and interior parts.

### SCREENING CAMPS

We conduct screening camps in collaboration with government hospitals and the community to ensure early identification and timely intervention. These camps not only help in detecting conditions such as wax, infections, or other issues that may cause hearing loss but also serve as a platform to counsel parents on audiological developmental milestones. Referrals and follow-ups are facilitated, ensuring children receive the right care at the right time.

### HIGHLIGHT

A collaboration with the ENT team at Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital (KDAH) enabled the conduct of a newborn hearing screening camp. The team supported with PTA testing, ear check-ups, and consultations for parents. This collaboration marks the beginning of an ongoing partnership, with plans to organize more such camps in the future to strengthen early detection and intervention.

### PUPPET SHOW

Through this simple yet creative activity, children absorbed new language in a fun and natural way while also reinforcing positive social habits. The children also were a part of a puppet making activity after the puppet show.



## AVT & SPEECH THERAPY

We believe every child deserves the gift of voice. Through **Auditory Verbal Therapy (AVT)**, children with hearing loss learn to listen, understand, and express themselves with confidence. Our activity based sessions focus on building strong communication skills for life. Today, we proudly support 48 children on this journey—and their parents are right there with them! With our guidance, families bring therapy into everyday life, turning each moment into a language-learning opportunity.



## FIRST CALL AND COUNSELING



The first counseling session at Montfort Care is a gentle beginning of the intervention journey for parents. They are guided through the audiological and therapy process.

Parents are informed about available support system which Centre provides towards their child's journey of listening, and communication.

## AUDIOLOGICAL INTERVENTION

Regular audiological tests are conducted to monitor children's hearing levels, track progress with hearing aids or cochlear implants, and guide therapy goals.

## ASSESSMENTS- THERAPY



On 24th and 25th September, we conducted 6-monthly assessments for children. Each child was gently guided through tools like the Integrated Scales of Development (ISD) and Preschool Language Scales (PLS), chosen according to their individual needs to evaluate progress in listening, speech, and language development. Parents were also counselled on their child's current target levels and guided on how they can support the next stage of growth




The activities conducted this quarter were to build their confidence, communication, and social skills. Children have started loud reading.
